



#### Spending £850m wisely, not saving £200m badly

Headline: Year of care costs: £2,189 to £2,800 if we don't change, we need to aim for c.£2,300





## Improvements that can be made by new models of 'Accountable Care'

#### Personal

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Enhance the quality and experience of patient care (the care and quality gap) Population

Improve health outcomes of populations (the health and well being gap) System

Reduce the per capita cost of care (the funding and efficiency gap)

## Engagement and co-design of new care model

- Phase 1: January to March 2016
  - Initial discussions, develop understanding
- Phase 2: September 2016 March 2017
  - Engagement to inform the outcomes we want to deliver and the design of the model, and how it will be implemented
- Phase 3: April 2017 March 2018
  - Engagement to inform implementation and local accountability during the initial test year of the new model.





- We want to make sure the outcomes we expect for our model of 'accountable' care are the outcomes that matter to local people
- We want to discuss with local people what outcomes are most important to them.
